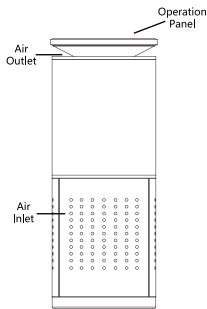

Getting Started

1. Unpack the air purifier from the box.
2. Plug in the Type-C cable to the power port at the middle-back of the air purifier, make sure the connection is secure and put the USB to the car charger/USB port along in the car/USB power adapter.

Operation Interface:



CONTROLS

ON/OFF

1. Place the product in the cup holder and connect the USB power cord to the USB port in the car
2. After powerup, the purifier starts at low wind speed. The switch turns blue and light is on. At the same time, the ambient light is also on until the entire machine is turned off;
3. Press the switch, and the air purifier enters the mode of middle wind speed. At this time, the touch panel turns green;
4. Touch the switch again, and the the air purifier enters the high mode. At this time, the touch panel turns red and the air volume reaches the maximum;
5. Touch the switch for the third time, and the product is in standby mode. At this time, the touch panel light goes out, the ambient light enters the breathing state. The car air purifier will be on low-speed mode once you press the switch again.

HEPA FILTER STRUCTURE

1. Pre-Filter

Helps to neutralize large particles such as lint, fibers, hair and pet fur.

2. True HEPA-13 Filter

Traps 99.97% of fine particles such as PM2.5, bacteria, viruses, cigarette smoke, dust & pollen, and other allergens small as 0.3 microns.

3. Photocatalyst filter

This filter can kill virus and bacteria effectively. The killing rate even reaches 99.95%

WARNING

- HEPA filter and wind inlet should be cleaned gently by using a vacuum cleaner to suck away dust and debris from the surface of them. More frequent cleaning may be necessary, depending on the air quality.
- Use a damp cloth to wipe the wind inlet.
- **REMEMBER** filters are non-washable, water should not be used on HEPA filters.

MAINTENANCE

Safety Protection Tips

- Any service other than regular cleaning or filter replacement should be performed by qualified electrician. Failure to comply could result in a voided warranty.
- This air purifier must only be connected to the car charger/USB port along in the car/USB power adapter.
- If not in the vehicle/indoor for a long time, please turn off the air purifier for energy saving and prolong the HEPA Filter's life time.
- Avoid touching any moving parts within the air purifier. Never insert fingers or any other objects through the fan guard.
- For maximum performance and safety should keep the air inlet clear.
- Do not place any object on top of the touch panel, in case of unintended activation.
- Always shut off the unit and unplug from the power cable before cleaning or performing any maintenance.
- Avoid touching any moving parts within the air purifier. Never insert fingers or any other objects through the fan guard.
- Do not clean the unit by spraying it or immersing it in water. Use a damp cloth only. Never allow water or vapors to enter the air purifier unit.

TROUBLESHOOTING

ISSUE	CHECK
Not Working	1. Check the power cable is connected and is the correct rating. 2. Make sure the filter cover is sealed. 3. The HEPA Filter must be in place. 4. Ensure the front panel and the air purifier unit are undamaged.
Buttons Blinking	1. Press the ON/OFF buttons for 10 seconds to reset the Filter Lifetime.
Abnormal Pollutant Smells, Loud noise when running	1. Check if the filter is clean. 2. Replace the filter
